



**Oslo**

Oslo, the capital of Norway, is the central hub of the railway network. Key stations in Oslo include: Oslo, Lillestrøm, Sandnessjøen, Moss, Drammen, Skjellestad, Ski, Torshov, St. Olavs plass, Nationaltheatret, and Nydalen.

**Trondheim**

Trondheim is a major city in the north. Key stations include: Trondheim, Heimdal, Melhus Skystasjon, and Støren.

**Bergen**

Bergen is a major city in the west. Key stations include: Bergen, Vaksdal, Dale, Arna, and Voss.

**Stavanger**

Stavanger is a major city in the south. Key stations include: Stavanger, Sandnes Sentrum, Bryne, Egersund, and Moi.

**Kristiansand**

Kristiansand is a major city in the south. Key stations include: Kristiansand, Vernesia, and Arendal.

- Åndalsnes**: Key stations include Andalsnes, Bjørli, Lesjaverk, Lesja, Dombås, and Dovre.
- Lillehammer**: Key stations include Lillehammer, Moelv, Brumunddal, and Lunner.
- Ålesund**: Key stations include Ålesund, Rindal, and Sandnessjøen.
- Alta**: Key stations include Alta, Kåfjord, and Ullsfjord.
- Hammerfest**: Key stations include Hammerfest, Honningsvåg, and Skjellestad.
- Haslum**: Key stations include Haslum, Skjellestad, and Røyne.
- Trondheim**: Key stations include Trondheim, Heimdal, Melhus Skystasjon, and Støren.
